The regional S.T.O.P.P program is comprised of local peninsula and south county law enforcement traffic enforcement teams (Marina, Seaside, Monterey, Pacific Grove, Carmel, Salinas and Greenfield). Each month, the team comes together and provides aggressive traffic related enforcement in local cities. If you are driving through Seaside this Thursday, be sure to wear your seatbelt, drive the speed limit, and follow the rules and laws while on the roadway. Seaside will have many officers looking for violators.
