In light of the tragic school shooting in Parkland Florida, and a recent hoax that impacted numerous schools around the nation (to include Seaside High School), the Seaside Police Department is taking a proactive approach by addressing school safety concerns through a symposium. Seaside Police will offer safety talks on police response to such violence, violence prevention, school safety, and reporting suspicious activity. There will also be an open forum in which school faculty, parents and students can ask questions and get to know our officers.

The Seaside Police Department's goals are to build a strong relationship with our local schools and students, prevent violence, and reassure our community of our commitment to keeping our residents safe during critical situations.
