Discharge of a Firearm

Seaside, CA
March 13, 2018

On March 13, around 1:20pm, Seaside officers were called to Seaside High School after a teacher was believed to have accidentally discharged a firearm in a classroom. The teacher was identified as Dennis Alexander. Alexander is also a reserve police officer for the City of Sand City. Alexander was believed to have been providing instruction related to public safety awareness. No one was seriously injured during the incident. An investigation is underway and school has resumed. The Seaside Police Department will be working closely with the Seaside High School as the investigation proceeds.
